Communication, Language & Literacy

This term we are focusing newspaper reports and autobiographies. Focusing biases, language features, events in our life, formal language and current events We will continue to focus on Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar as well as focusing on comprehension and guided reading.

Science

The learner will look in detail at buoyancy, structure, tensile strength, air resistance. We will apply these concepts to real world scenarios such as car safety, PPE, designing our own vehicles such as buoyant boats. We will also test and adapt our designs.

My Community, the Empire and the World

Geography

The British Empire

This term we will be looking at the British Empire, good, bad or something in the middle? Focusing on the different countries it occupied and their cultural impact on each other. We will look at the rise and fall of an empire, questioning how it affects our supply chains and relations to this day.

Citizenship

Community and Volunteering

In this term we will look at helping others and our local community. We will challenge our identity and think about the local culture in our area. We will look at special interest groups and think about how we can have a greater impact in our community.

Numeracy & Problem Solving

In this unit students focus on fractions, percentages and decimals. Focusing on applying these skills to a variety of contexts such as algebra, problem solving, data interpretation. We will also continue to revisit shape.

Computing

The learner will develop their understanding of applications and digital media. We look at how we can use and apply our computing skills to take and edit photos as well as using a variety of other useful applications.

DofE

In DofE this year our class will be focusing on their Silver/Gold award. This involves an expedition; volunteering, giving their time to benefit others; skills, developing an interest or hobby that they have; physical, working on improving their health and fitness.
