














Communication, Language & Literacy

What are the different types of recounts?

This half term students will be focusing on recounts. In particular, diaries, newspaper reports, autobiographies and biographies. Students will be in their English groups and focus on a particular text to help with their understanding of this and how recounts are structured, before attempting to write their own. Guided reading sessions will also continue on a weekly basis to help students to develop their literacy skills.

Science

What ways have animals changed over time?

The focus for this half term will be on the development of animals including humans. Students will build on their seasonal knowledge to help understand how animals change as they grow. There will also be a discovery on how the human skeleton works and how different food groups can contribute to a healthy lifestyle. Students will learn the skill of identifying and classifying animals to further enhance their knowledge.

Enrichment & Ways to Wellbeing

Students will continue to have weekly PSHE lessons to help understand how to celebrate being different and to further enhance their understanding of themselves. Weekly swimming lessons will continue to take place to improve their health and wellbeing. In addition, weekly Commando Joe's lessons will allow students to develop their teamwork and problem-solving skills.

Geography

How are rivers and coasts different in parts of the world?

This term students will focus on Geography and understanding how climates are different across the world. Students will discover what the weather is like in certain parts of the world and why this is important to maintain a healthy world. Students will also use their understanding of physical and human geographical features to help understand rivers and coasts.

RE

Why do Christians believe in the Messiah?

Students will be developing their understanding of Christianity by exploring Christian beliefs on the Messiah and how their beliefs may be similar or different to others. Students will reflect on this and have more of an understanding of other cultures and why it is important to respect this.

Physical Education

What are the rules of Hockey?

The next focus in PE this half term is Hockey. Students will begin to understand the basic rules of Hockey and develop the skills needed to participate safely in Hockey based games. Understanding of how to hold a hockey stick and accurately play a variety of shots will take place. There will be a focus on teamwork and respect to help students.

Maths & Problem Solving

How can I multiply and divide numbers?

In this half term, students will be learning how to multiply and divide numbers. This is an essential skill to apply this to real life problems. Students will practice techniques in which they can use a way which works best for them to solve more complex mathematical problems.

Computing

How can I input data on a spreadsheet?

In Computing, students will look at how spreadsheets work and how large amounts of data can be organised into a spreadsheet to be more organised and to save time. Students will continue to develop their knowledge of Purple Mash to improve their skills on implementing spreadsheet data effectively.

Art & Design Technology

What are the different ways of transferring an image successfully?

During this half term, students will be learning about printing in Art. This will involve students creating a piece of art through drawing or painting and transferring it accurately onto another surface. The surfaces will vary and will be wood, metal or glass based on other artists creations. This will be developed further by using tools in DT to make their own designs safely.
