


Puffin Class learning plan

Communication, language and literacy

Phonics— We will continue to develop phonological knowledge and applying within reading and writing.

Literacy—(recounts) we will read and identify features of biographies, diaries and newspaper reports and create our own around topics of interest. To develop oracy skills we will carry out interviews and give presentations.

Guided reding— our group text will be 'A daredevils guide to dangerous places' developing skills in each area of comprehension.

Fine motor skills / handwriting— letter formation (size and orientation) We will also complete individual 1:1 reading matched to reading stages and reading for pleasure choosing books from the library.

Science

How do I grow and change?

We will identify the parts of the human body and how we use our senses. By exploring the life cycle of humans and animals we will identify how we change and what we need to survive.

Maths and problem solving

Can I use Multiplication and division?

We will be following the 'White rose' Maths scheme and developing multiplication and division skills including counting in given increments, identifying, creating and adding equal groups and making and using arrays. Some learners will multiply and divide numbers and explore related calculations and facts.

We will also take part in a weekly shopping and cooking session to apply our Maths skills within practical contexts.

Computing

How can I make my writing stand out?

We will be looking at how to create and present information using ICT to support. We will learn how to change and edit text and how this creates different effects and create news reports, letters and posters for given purposes.

Humanities

Where is the most dangerous place on Earth?

Extreme earth: We will identify what the earth is made up of and explore extreme events including volcano eruptions, tsunami's, earthquakes and tornadoes and what impact this has on the earth.

Enrichment and ways to wellbeing

How can I achieve my dreams and goals?

We will identify ambitions for the future and explore how we can learn and develop new skills and deal with challenges. We will also continue work around the 'zones of regulation' identifying and communicating emotions and using strategies to support our self-regulation as well as daily hygiene routines.

Art, music and DT

How can I use different printing techniques to create patterns?

We will be exploring making prints using a range of printing techniques and looking at how famous artists used this in their own work to create patterns.

What happens when a volcano erupts?

We will be designing and building our own Volcanoes and creating structures to withstand extreme weather.

RE

What is the Holy trinity and why is it Important to Christians?

We will explore the meaning of the trinity and how we love, care and forgive in our own lives.

Skills

What are my skills and interests?

We will be identifying our individual skills and interests, researching job roles around this and creating our own enterprise activities to take part in on a weekly basis.
