

Communication, Language & Literacy

LC- Find out about a famous person

We will be learning how to find facts about famous people. We will be learning how to decipher fact from fiction and discuss opinions.

Phonics – In daily phonics sessions we will develop our knowledge of general sounds, spelling, writing and ability to decode and segment words.

Science

LC- Plant identification

We will be looking at, examining and identifying plants and the different parts of a plant. We will use herbs and spices taken from plants in practical cooking sessions.

As Scientists we will be recording likes and dislikes of smells taste and texture from a variety of plants.

PSHE, Enrichment & Ways to Wellbeing

PSHE -LC –Understanding own personal hygiene.

We will be learning about and participating in practical activitivites related to personal hygiene and the benefits of following a regular routine.

<u>Citizenship</u> – <u>Experiencing different cultures</u>. We will be taking part in events to celebrate the culture of different countries.

On completion of each Lifeskills Challenge (LC) students will be awarded a certificate outlining skills and processes demonstrated

Humanities

LC – Exploring the local area and community

We will be participating in a range of activities that will enable students to experience and explore a variety of buildings including museums, markets and sports grounds.

Preparation for Adulthood

LC Cooking dishes from around the world

We will be learning about different countries around the world. Students will cook dishes from a selection of countries; they will demonstrate and build upon skills needed to carry out tasks safely in a kitchen.

Numeracy & Problem Solving

LC Telling the time at o'clock

We will be learning to tell the time at o clock on both analogue and digital clocks and sequence key events in the day. Students will be using a variety of resources to demonstrate their knowledge and understanding of time.

Computing

LC – Using ICT in the home

We will be identifying a variety of ICT equipment used in the home. We will demonstrate how to use ICT equipment safely.

The Arts

LC –Making decorations for a special event

This half term we will be focusing on design and technology. Designing and making a decoration using a wide variety of materials. Exploring and experiencing different equipment needed to create the decoration

Physical Education

In PE we will be developing our skills of team work problem solving and resilience.
