Term: 24/25 Summer 2

Books to support our learning.



Communication, Language & Literacy

This term, we are focusing on building confidence with exams and improving comprehension skills. Pupils will practise writing imaginative stories, developing structure, character and setting. We are also working on speaking and listening through discussions and presentations. Regular reading continues to support understanding and vocabulary development.

Science

Space

We are learning about space physics, including the solar system, gravity, and the phases of the moon. Pupils will investigate how day and night occur and how Earth's movements affect seasons. We'll also explore how scientific models explain space phenomena.

PSHE

Relationships and Changing Me

Our topic is relationships and understanding our changing bodies. We'll talk about emotional and physical changes in a safe and respectful environment. Pupils will also explore positive relationships and consent.



Travel

Topic

Global History and Travel and Tourism

Our topic is *History in the World*, part of the ASDAN short course. Pupils will look at key global events and how history is understood and presented in different cultures. They'll work on independent research and presenting findings clearly. In Geography pupils will look at why people travel, popular destinations, and the impact of tourism on local environments. They'll consider both the benefits and challenges of the tourism industry.

Citizenship

Finance

We are learning how to manage personal finance. This includes understanding budgeting, saving, and spending choices. Pupils will also explore needs versus wants and financial decision-making.

Numeracy & Problem Solving

Our focus is on directed number, including using positive and negative numbers in different contexts. We will also explore properties of 2D and 3D shapes, including angles and symmetry. Problem-solving and reasoning skills will be developed throughout.

Computing

This term we are looking at messaging in digital media. Pupils will explore how we communicate online and how to use digital tools safely and responsibly. They will also learn how messages can be adapted for different audiences.

DofE

In DofE this year our class will be focusing on their Silver/Gold award. This involves an expedition; volunteering, giving their time to benefit others; skills, developing an interest or hobby that they have; physical, working on improving their health and fitness. If your young person did silver last year they will need to do a residential also

Physical Education

We are playing rounders and focusing on developing teamwork, striking, and fielding skills. We're also learning about bike safety, including basic maintenance and road awareness.
