Communication, Language & Literacy What goes in a discussion text?

In our English groups, we'll be examining what the features of a discussion text. We'll look at how the piece should be unbiased and give both sides of the argument. With our guided reading, we'll be using the media film of Beowulf.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World Who were the Anglo-saxons?
