

















Communication, Language & Literacy

In English - Short stories, your child will learn how to read and understand short stories, how writers use write their own short stories using imagination and

characters, settings and plots to tell a story, and how to creativity...

Science

How does my body grow and adapt to help me do different things?

In Science – My body, your child will learn how to test and measure their reaction speed, how hand—eve coordination helps them in everyday tasks, and how people grow and change throughout different stages of life.

PSHE

How can I transition to being an adulty in society?

In PSHE – Me and my world – Becoming an adult and the law, your child will learn about the rights and responsibilities they will have as an adult, the role of laws in keeping people safe, and how to make sensible choices as they become more independent. In Citizenship – My rights and responsibilities, your child will learn what it means to have rights in society, that rights come with responsibilities to others, and how they can contribute positively to their community.



Me and My World

Geography - My Place

What places are important to people and why?

In My place – My local area, your child will learn to recognise key features of their local area, use maps and simple directions to explore their surroundings, and understand why their community is special and how they belong to it.

History

Why is it important to learn about local history?

In Our local history – The importance of understanding local history, your child will learn about important events and people from the past, how history has shaped the place where they live today, and why it is important to value and respect the heritage of their community.

Numeracy & Problem Solving

Term: 25/26 Autumn 1

In Number, Sequences – Spotting patterns and place value, your child will learn how to recognise and continue number patterns, understand the value of each digit in a number, and use patterns and place value to solve problems.

Computing

This unit covers how to search for and select appropriate information to meet personal and organisational needs. Learners will understand how to evaluate the information they find, understand copyright, and be able to store information in line with organisational procedures.

DofE

In DofE this year our class will be focusing on their Silver/Gold award. This involves an expedition; volunteering, giving their time to benefit others; skills, developing an interest or hobby that they have; physical, working on improving their health and fitness.

Physical Education
