#### Communication, Language & Literacy

We will explore how to write engaging and imaginative narrative. They will read and discuss examples of narrative texts, looking at how authors create atmosphere, build suspense, and develop interesting characters. Pupils will learn how to plan, draft, and edit their own stories, using a clear structure with a beginning, middle, and end.

# What is the difference between a lever, a gear and a pulley?

To recognise that some mechanisms, including levers, pulleys and gears, allow a smaller force to have a greater effect. To report and present findings from enquiries, including conclusions, causal relationships and explanations of and degree of trust in results, in oral and written forms such as displays and other presentations.

## What do some deities tell sanatanis about God?

In this enquiry, the children learn about a selection of different deities and what they demonstrate about Brahman. We will look at the importance of deities to those that practice Hinduism around the world

## Physical Education

#### Handba

In this unit pupils develop their understanding of the attacking and defending principles of invasion games. In all games activities, pupils have to think about how they use skills, strategies and tactics to outwit the opposition. Pupils develop their understanding of the importance of fair play and honesty while self-managing games, learning, and abiding by key rules, as well as evaluating their own and others' performances.

#### Maths & Problem Solving

In our new Maths groups, we shall focus on place value and the four operations, as they are the foundations of all of our maths. We will use manipulatives and the use of concrete, pictorial and abstract methods to help develop our understanding. We will have regular mental arithmetic sessions to help us with our daily-use maths such as shopping. We will continue our use of TT Rockstars in class.

## How can I keep myself safe online?

As part of our start to the new academic year, we will refresh with the children the importance of online safety. We will work together to establish a set of classroom rules for when we use our computers in school. We'll be able to explain who we can go to if we have concerns about anything we see online.
