Communication, Language & Literacy

Through the non-fiction book 'Survivors' we will develop our understanding of poetry, recounts, information texts and pamphlets.

We will take part in daily individual reading sessions and weekly pleasure reading sessions.

Science: Earth & Space

In Science, we will begin to explore the solar system and space, describing how ideas about space and the Solar System have changed over time; identify the celestial bodies of the Solar System, including the Sun, Earth and Moon before identifying and describing the phases of the Moon and naming the eight planets in the Solar System.

Physical Education: Bouldering & Fitness

This half term we will be developing our bouldering skills at Willowburn every Monday. We will learn how to climb safely and develop our body strength and stamina. On Fridays, we will focus on our fitness levels and stamina

Numeracy & Problem Solving:

We will continue to develop our addition, subtraction, multiplication and division skills with larger numbers before moving on to fractions. We will have regular opportunities to develop our multiplication skills through Times Table Rock Stars and Hit the Button.

History: The Vikings & Anglo-Saxons

We will learn how and why the Vikings invaded. Why did the Vikings come to Britain? How did they travel? Then think about how the Vikings who settled in Britain lived? How artefacts help us to work out what life was like in the past and why Alfred the Great and 1066 are significant to this era of history.

P.S.H.E.: Celebrating Differences

This half term we will continue to use Jigsaw to support our learning. In P.S.H.E. we will learn how to challenge prejudices and celebrate differences.

R.E.: The Nativity

In R.E. we will think about the most significant part of the Nativity story for Christians today.

Computing: Blogging & game creator

We will use 2Blog on Purple Mash to learn how to write and edit blogs while reminding ourselves how to stay safe online and only comment respectfully on the blogs of others. This is followed by game creator.

Art: Colour Chaos

In Art we will investigate tints, tones and shades of colour inspired by a range of artists including Mondrian, Jackson Pollock and Paul Klee.

Design Technology: Food

In Design technology we will continue to develop our cooking skills and hygiene awareness.

Careers

Understand what a "career for change" means, recognising that many jobs can contribute to solving real-world problems. They will reflect on their strengths in relation to future careers.
