






Books to support our learning.

Communication, Language & Literacy

What is a recount and what are the features to look out for?
In daily phonics sessions, we will develop our knowledge of general sounds, spelling, writing and ability to decode and segment words in line with individual targets. Those doing literacy will be working on Recount texts. We will take part in daily supported reading sessions and pleasure reading sessions, as well as reading 'Paddington and the Grand tour' as a whole class.

ScienceWhat types of material are there and can you name them?

In Science, this half term we will learn all about the materials that we see and use every day. We will look at classifying different materials and start to distinguish between objects and identify the materials they are made from.

The ArtsWhat techniques can I use to create different sculptures?

This half term we will be expanding our knowledge of clay and developing such skills as joining clay and sculpting clay. We will also look at colour mixing, using complimentary colours and using patterns in our work.
