Books to support our learning.



Communication, Language & Literacy

In English – Non-fiction texts, your child will learn how to read and understand a range of non-fiction texts, including instructions, explanations and non-chronological reports. They will explore how writers organise information clearly, use key features and subject-specific language, and will learn to write their own non-fiction texts to inform and explain.

Science

How do substances change and react?

In Science – Chemical changes, your child will learn how substances react to form new materials, how to identify chemical changes, and how factors such as temperature and mixing affect reactions. They will carry out investigations, make observations, and understand how chemical changes are used in everyday life.

PSHE

How can I transition to being a healthy, confident adult in society?

In PSHE – Healthy Me, your child will learn about pregnancy, sexual health, relationships, and self-esteem. They will explore how to make safe, informed choices, understand the importance of respect and consent, and develop confidence and self-worth as they prepare for adulthood.

How does democracy work in society?

In Citizenship – Democracy, your child will learn what democracy is, why it is important, and how people can have a voice in decision-making. They will explore ways citizens can participate in democratic processes, understand fairness and representation, and learn how rules and laws are shaped in a democratic society.



Exploring the World

Geography – My Place

How are landscapes shaped and why do they matter to people?

In Geography – Physical processes, your child will learn about weathering, erosion, and other forces that shape the Earth's surface. They will explore how these processes affect different places, why certain landscapes are important to people, and how humans interact with and care for their environment.

History

Why is it important to understand Britain and the Empire?

In History – Britain and the Empire, your child will learn about key events, people, and places in British history and its global connections. They will explore how the Empire has shaped modern Britain, consider different perspectives from the past, and understand why studying history helps us value heritage and learn from past decisions.

How can I use numbers and shapes to solve problems?

In Maths, your child will learn to understand and apply place value, work confidently with fractions, and explore properties of shapes and geometry. They will also develop problem-solving skills and prepare for their NCFE exams to demonstrate their mathematical knowledge and reasoning.

Computing

How can I use digital tools to find, evaluate, and organise information?

In Computing – Minecraft Education, your child will learn how to search for and select accurate and relevant information to meet different needs. They will explore how to evaluate the reliability of information, respect copyright, and store and organise data.

DoFE

In DoFE this year our class will be focusing on their Silver/Gold award. This involves an expedition; volunteering, giving their time to benefit others; skills, developing an interest or hobby that they have; physical, working on improving their health and fitness.

Physical Education

We will develop our movement, improving our stamina and staying healthy through two weekly PE sessions. Each week, we will be keeping active as well as daily exercise.
