Books to support our learning.



Communication, Language & Literacy

How do writers use structure and language to create suspense and engage the reader?

Pupils will explore short stories (including Sherlock Holmes), analysing how tension is built and characters are developed. They will plan and write their own suspense narratives, focusing on structure, description and vocabulary choices.

Science

How does the body respond and adapt to exercise?

Pupils will study the muscular and skeletal systems, nutrition, and the aerobic and anaerobic energy systems. They will link scientific knowledge to performance and investigate how the body produces and uses energy..

PSHE

How can I stay safe in a sexual relationships?

Pupils will learn about consent, respect, and the importance of clear communication in relationships. They will explore how to recognise pressure or unhealthy behaviours, understand their rights, and know where to seek support to keep themselves safe.

Citizenship

How are laws created and changed in the UK?

Pupils will explore the purpose of laws, how Parliament works, and how citizens can influence change. They will consider rights, responsibilities and the justice system.



Geography – Global Trade

How does global trade affect the lives of people around the world?

Pupils will investigate imports, exports and supply chains, exploring how goods move across the world. They will examine the impact of trade on economies, jobs and communities.

History

How did the Tudors change Britain?

Children will study key Tudor monarchs and significant events, exploring changes in religion, power and daily life. They will use historical evidence to understand how this period shaped modern Britain.

Maths

How can I use numbers and shapes to solve problems?

In Maths, your child will learn to understand and apply place value, work confidently with fractions, and explore properties of shapes and geometry. They will also develop problem-solving skills and prepare for their NCFE exams to demonstrate their mathematical knowledge and reasoning

Computing

How can we stay safe in a digital world?

Children will learn about online threats, data protection and safe digital practices. They will explore how cybersecurity works and why protecting information is important.

DofE

In DofE this year our class will be focusing on their Silver/Gold award. This involves an expedition; volunteering, giving their time to benefit others; skills, developing an interest or hobby that they have; physical, working on improving their health and fitness.

Physical Education
