
**Barndale Learning Plan**

**Books to support our learning**

**Literacy**

In literacy we will be building upon our creative writing from last half term. We will be focusing on the features of a recount, specifically newspapers. We will then apply the skills we have learnt to writing a newspaper article linked to our book 'The Man Who Walk Between The Towers'.



**Science**

**How plants survive?**

This half term we will be exploring plants. We will be looking at plants' full life cycle from germination to seed dispersal. We will experiment with different growing conditions and exploring pollination.

**Humanities**

**What changed happened between the Stone Age and the Iron Age?**

This half term we will be exploring the key events and characteristics of both the Stone Age and the Iron Age. We will then be comparing the two to see how it changed and the factors that caused these changes.

**PSHE**

**How can I best keep my self safe?**

This half term we will be completing the Speak Out Stay Safe program from NSPCC. This helps young people to understand what abuse is and how to feel supported and able to talk to adults.

**PE**

**Numeracy**

In numeracy, we will continue to build our calculation skills focusing on a range of skills including addition and subtraction, fractions and multiplication and division. We will then use our knowledge to solve problems. In our learning, we will use TTRockStars and Numbots online to support our learning.
