







Books to support our learning.



Communication, Language & Literacy

In literacy we will be focusing on travel writing, using Holes (our guided reading text) as a driver for learning. We will develop our wider reading skills, with a particular focus this half term on vocabulary and work towards writing a persuasive travel booklet for our own camp. The class text will also tie in with our learning on crime and punishment.

STEM

How do humans change as they grow?

In this unit we will explore changes in humans and animals as they grow, including puberty. We will look at gestation periods and compare those of different animals as well as looking at average lifespans of humans and animals and changes that take place at different points in the lifespans of humans and animals.

PSHE

How do my choices affect my health?

In PSHE we will be learning about the health risks of smoking and misusing alcohol, how to practice basic first aid, how to get help in an emergency situation, pressures around body image and the role of food. We will explore how to make an informed decision, resist pressure, find support and how to respect and value ourselves.



Historical Crime & Punishment

Humanities

Did the punishment always fit the crime in the past?

In our history lessons we will learn about different types of crime committed across various historical periods and how these crimes were punished. We will explore how justice systems evolved over times and what this reveals about society in different eras.

Therapeutic Input

In class we will be focusing on sensory activities in the classroom to support our regulation. This will include Tuff Tray challenges and calming activities.

Numeracy & Problem Solving

In maths we will be exploring measurement. We will learn to measure using the appropriate unit of measurement e.g millimetre, centimetre or meter as well as convert between these measurements. We will also learn to add and subtract lengths, compare lengths, and measure and calculate perimeters.

Computing

How can spreadsheets be helpful?

In this unit we will look at how we can use spreadsheets to input data and what formulae to solve problems. We will use totalling tools and investigate data.

The Arts

Can I design, plan and make a phone case?

This half term we will be designing, planning and making a felt phone case. We will look at different ways we can stitch and add design and try to follow a brief. We will continue with our weekly keyboard lessons.

Physical Education

How can I plan my movement?

In PE we will be exploring navigation and orienteering. The unit encourages children to explore the key skills required to work effectively with others and problem-solve, as well as utilise orienteering skills, including map reading, orientating a map and using a compass correctly.
