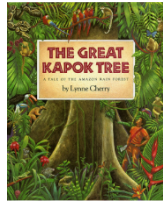

Communication, Language & Literacy
 Pupils will learn how to write like journalists by creating newspaper reports. We will explore key features such as headlines, engaging opening paragraphs, and organizing information using the 5 Ws. We will develop skills in summarizing information, structuring ideas, and using appropriate punctuation. By the end of the unit, pupils will produce their own newspaper report based on a real or imagined event.

Science
Does all life reproduce the same?
 During Science, we'll learn describe the life process of reproduction in some plants and animals. We will find out about the work of naturalists, conservationists and animal behaviourists, for example Sir David Attenborough and Dr Jane Goodall. We shall also plan different types of scientific enquiries to answer questions.

Enrichment & Ways to Wellbeing
 In the Badgers, we will embrace the impact of a positive mental health. Every week, we will have our classroom nominations where the pupils vote for their own star of the week whilst telling their chosen person why they are special. We will use Stormbreak activities & Just Dance to have movement breaks to stimulate the body as well as the mind. We will complete the Daily Mile every day.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World
Where Does Our Food Come From and How Is It affected by Climate?
 In this unit, we revisit and deepen their understanding of the world's countries and climate zones, using maps to locate geographical information. They learn about where the food they eat comes from and how far it has travelled, considering the impact of food production and distribution on climate change.

RE
What is the best for a Sanatani to show commitment to God?
 Sanatanis believe in Brahman as the one true God who is formless, limitless, all-inclusive, and eternal. This enquiry introduces the following aspects of Sanatani belief – Puja, Gayatri Mantra, Vedas, The four goals - (purusharthas) - Dharma (teaching)

Physical Education
 In this athletics unit, we will have the opportunity to develop their existing running, jumping and throwing skills. We will be running for speed and endurance as well as learning the technique for the standing vertical jump. We will also learn the technique for throwing the discus and practise other types of throwing techniques.

Maths & Problem Solving
 In Maths, our main focus across the half term is multiplication and division. Whilst some might be consolidating our times table recall and some might be looking at HTU x U, others will be looking at multiplication & division of decimals and fractions.

Computing
How are computer games made?
 The children will learn more about the world of gaming. Children will design and make their own 3D maze adventure game using the 2DIY3D tool, assessing the effectiveness of their own and other's creations.

Art & Design Technology
Champions of Art – Through the Window
 We will learn about the one-point perspective drawing technique, study artists who have utilised this technique in their work and then we will create our own one-point perspective drawing.
