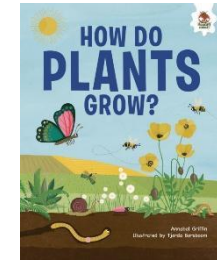
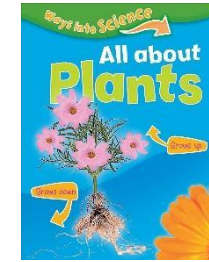
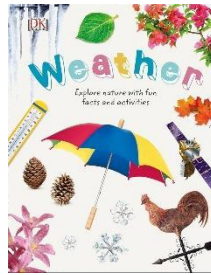
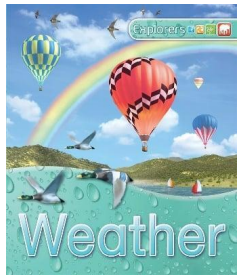


Books to support our learning.



Communication, Language & Literacy

How can I change the end of a story?

In daily phonics sessions, we will develop our knowledge of general sounds, spelling, writing and ability to decode and segment words in line with individual targets. Those doing literacy will be working on Instructional texts. We will take part in daily supported reading sessions and pleasure reading sessions, as well as reading 'Meesha makes friends' as a whole class.

Science

How do plants grow?

In Science, this half term we will be looking at how plants grow and what they need to grow. We will look at the effects of temperature, light and water on plants. We will observe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. As part of this we will take our learning out into forest school and Roots and Shoots at Alnwick Gardens.

PSHE, Enrichment & Ways to Wellbeing

In what way can I be a good friend and family member?

In our PSHE lessons, we will be coming together as a class to discover how we can become good friends and what qualities a good friend needs to have. We will also be taking a look at families, how we all have different families and that all are ok.

Weather Explorers!

Humanities

Is the weather the same across the world?

This half term we will be become Weather Explorers unit will enable children to learn about the different types of weather in their immediate environment. Children will then have the opportunity to build on this and knowledge of the four seasons. They will begin to explore how UK weather is similar or different to other places around the world by introducing them to hot and cold places of the world and the impact of different weather types.

Therapeutic Input

Those who receive input from SaLT and Thrive will continue to do so. We will have regular sensory breaks between lessons this half term and create our own individual regulation toolkits.

Numeracy & Problem Solving

What properties do 2d and 3d shapes have?

This half term we will be looking at 2D and 3D shapes. Before learning about the properties of shapes, we will need to recognise and name both 2-D and 3-D shapes and differentiate between them.

Computing

Can I create a game for my friends to play?

In computing, we will be starting to look at how we can use computers to paint pictures and create safe games to play. This unit gives children the opportunity to develop their mouse, keyboard and basic computing skills using creative tools. Children will use the 2DIY tools to paint, create jigsaws and make simple drag and drop games.

Art and Design Technology

How has food been portrayed through art?

This half term we will be looking at food and how it has been portrayed through art and DT. We will use clay and other materials to create different foods and we will also have a good go at drawing still life art using fruit.

Physical Education

How can I run faster and jump higher?

This half term we will be developing our running and jumping skills. We will look at the difference between jogging and sprinting and also look at different types of jumps.
