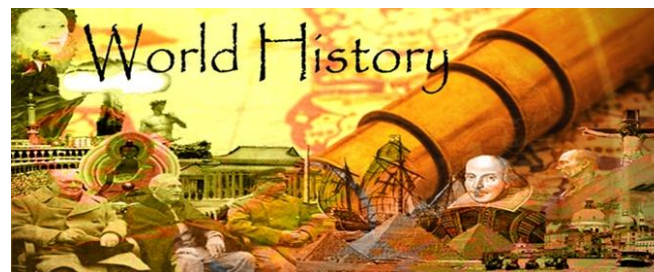
Books to support our learning.



Communication, Language & Literacy

How can we express our opinions clearly and persuasively?

In this topic, students will learn how to structure arguments, present evidence, and respond respectfully to different viewpoints. They will develop speaking and listening skills through a range of debate activities.



Maths

How do positive and negative numbers help us solve real-life problems?

Students will learn how to perform calculations with directed numbers and apply them to mathematical situations. They will also use equations to develop their problem-solving and reasoning skills.
