Books to support our learning

Literacy

Can we plan a picnic?

Students will continue to access their phonics and literacy in their allocated groups. Students will look at a range of texts to support their learning in their groups. We will explore instructional language and how to write instruction texts. We will also look at writing records of the key features. Hopefully this will help us plan the perfect picnic.
