Communication, Language & Literacy

We will develop our descriptive writing skills by creating detailed settings using vocabulary, imagery and the senses. We will explore dystopian settings and consider how authors create atmosphere, tension and a sense of place. We will apply these techniques to our own writing, focusing on structure, vocabulary and accurate punctuation.

Science

We will learn about the human body and how different body systems work together to keep us healthy. We will explore the importance of exercise, nutrition, sleep and other factors that contribute to physical and mental wellbeing. We will develop our scientific understanding by investigating how our bodies respond to different activities and demands.

PSHE

We will explore who we are and what makes us unique, considering our strengths, qualities and responsibilities. We will think about how our actions affect the people and communities around us. We will develop our understanding of belonging, teamwork and making positive choices.



Polar Pioneers

Geography – My Place

We will explore the Polar Regions, learning about their location, climate and unique physical features. We will investigate how people, animals and plants survive in these extreme environments. We will also consider the challenges facing the Polar Regions.

History

We will investigate the Qing Dynasty and learn about its development, rulers and influence on China. We will explore what life was like during this period for different groups of people. We will use historical evidence to understand how China changed during the Qing Dynasty and its place in
